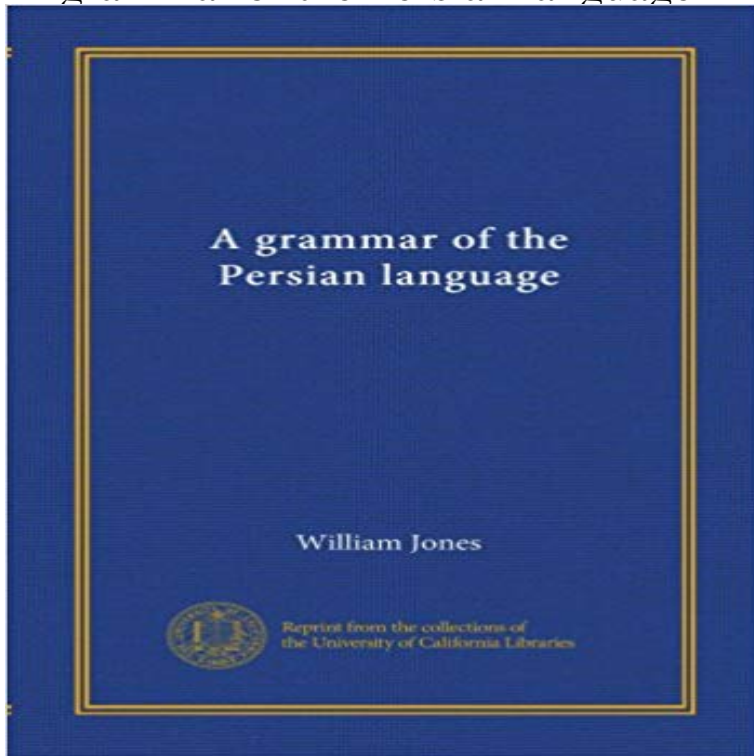


## A grammar of the Persian language
