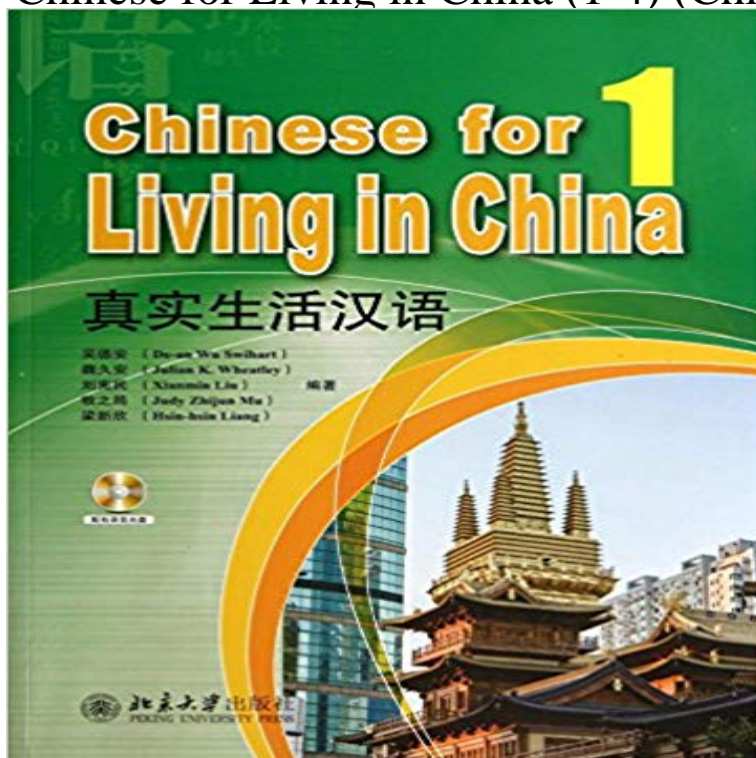


Chinese for Living in China (1-4) (Chinese Edition)
