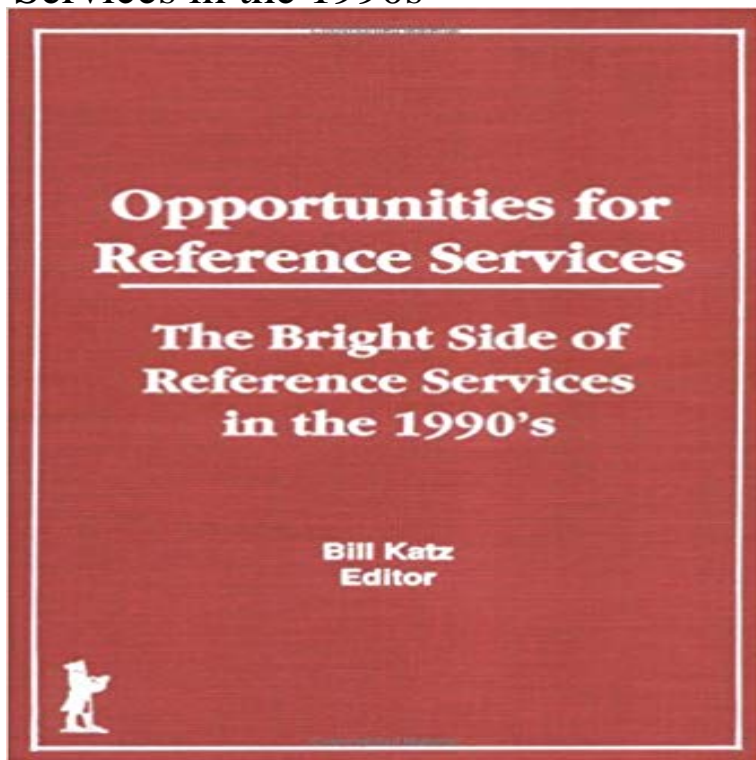


## Opportunities for Reference Services: The Bright Side of Reference Services in the 1990s
