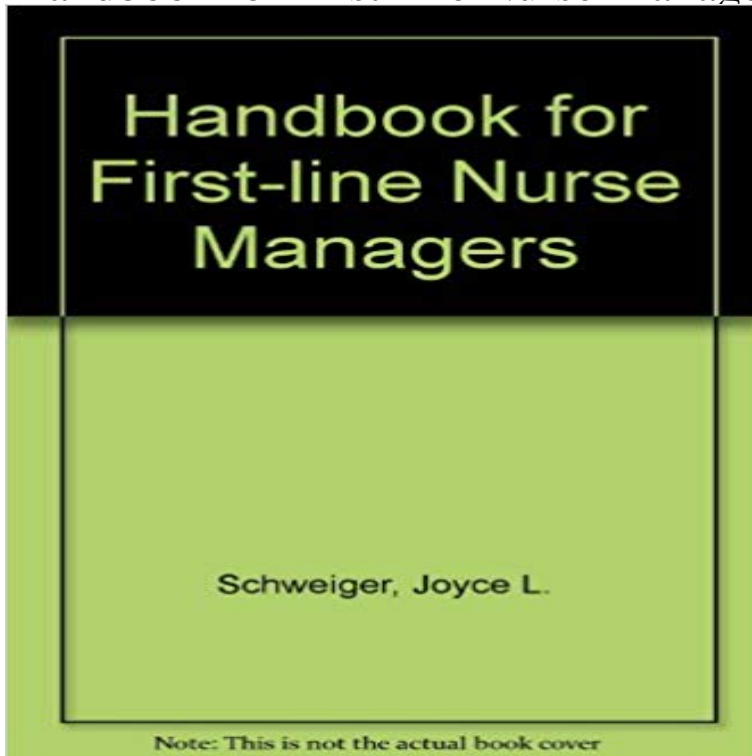


Handbook for First-line Nurse Managers (A Wiley medical publication)
