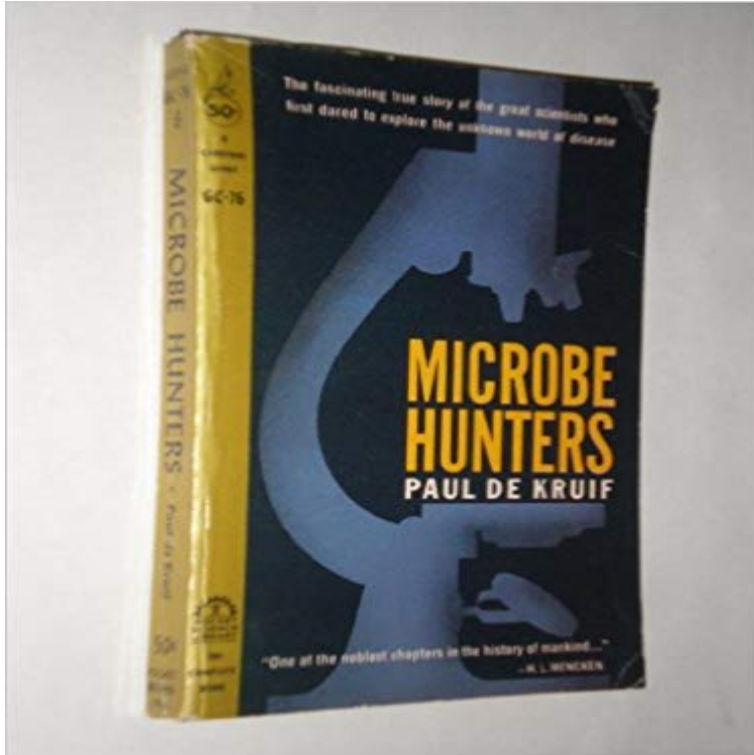


Microbe hunters.
