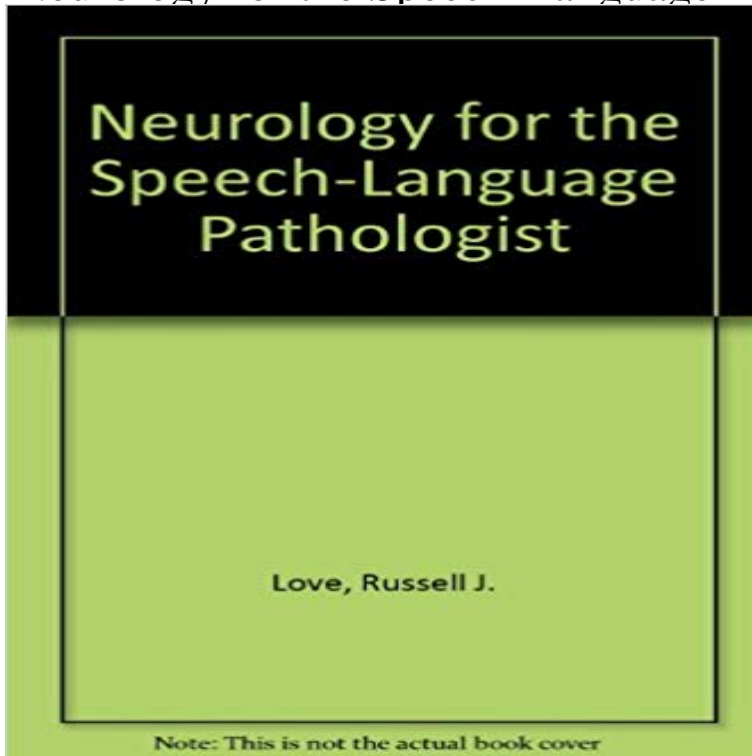


Neurology for the Speech-Language Pathologist
