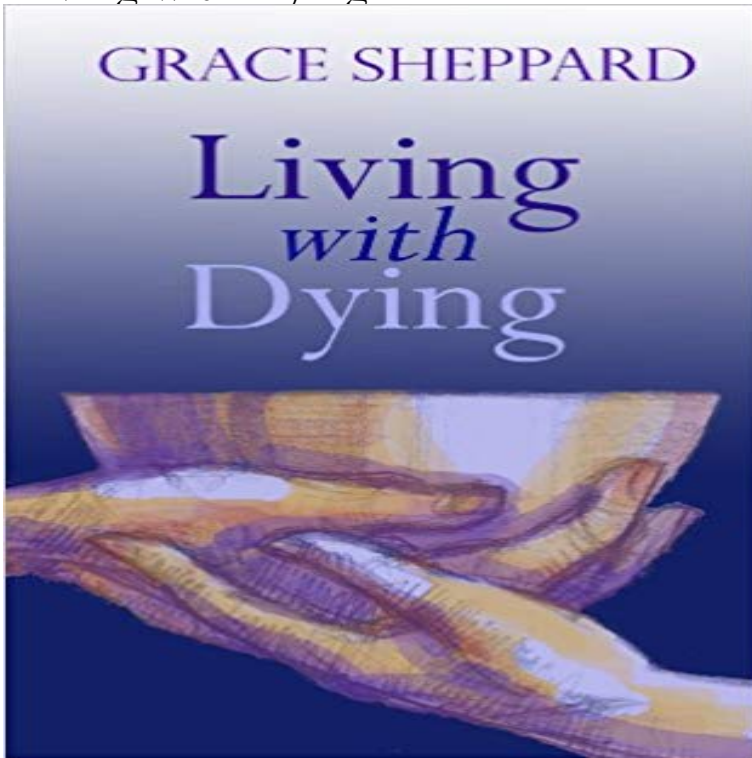


Living with Dying
