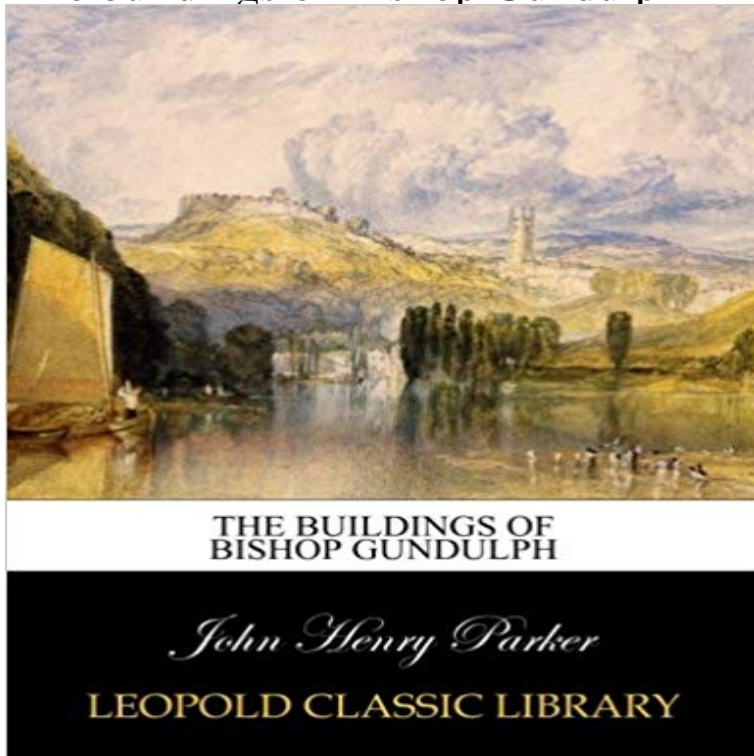


The buildings of Bishop Gundulph
