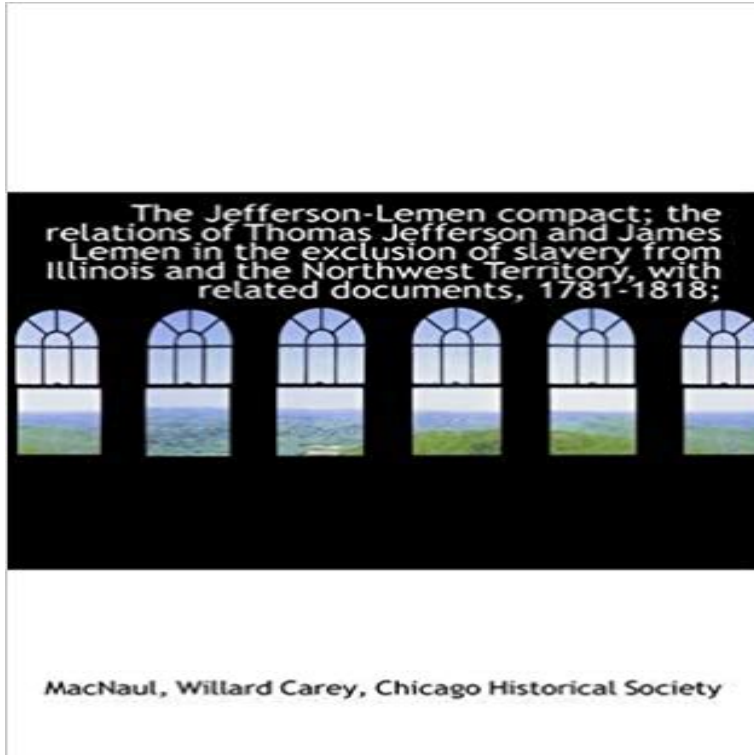


The Jefferson-Lemen compact; the relations of Thomas Jefferson and James Lemen in the exclusion of s
