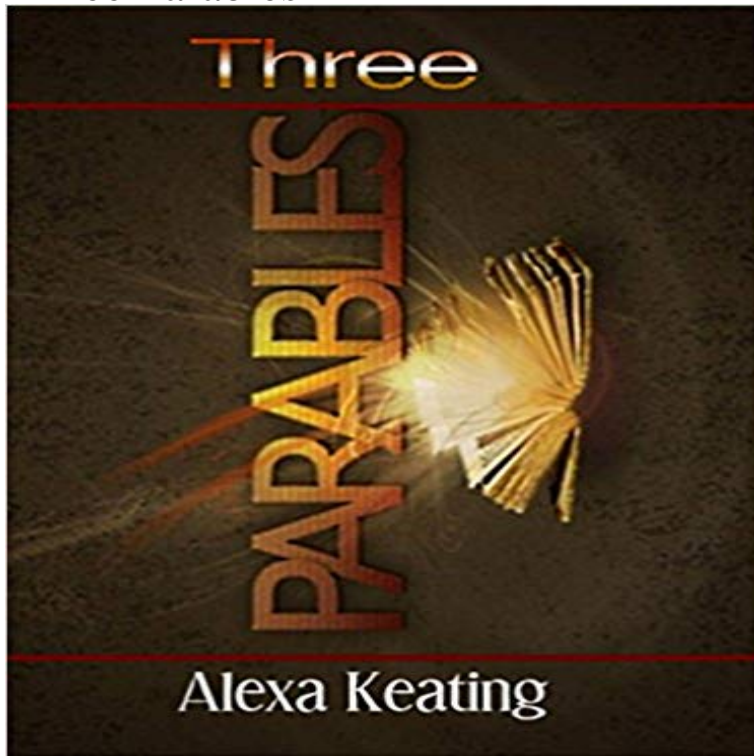


Three Parables
